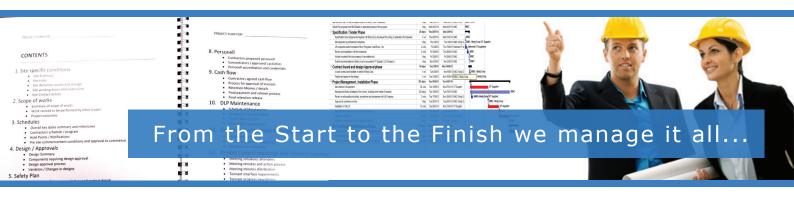

FAQs
